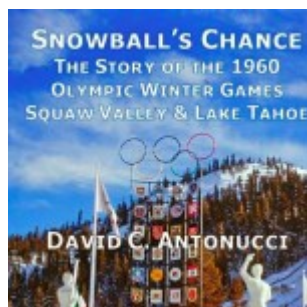


History of Squaw Olympics becomes a book
