

# Nevada casinos stop slide; Stateline still in trouble

While the statewide numbers are showing improvement, Stateline casinos continue to spiral downward when it comes to revenue.

Nevada stopped its 22-month skid to post a 4.35 percent gain from November 2008 to November 2009. This amounts to \$873.2 million dollars that Nevada casinos won from gamblers in November, the state Gaming Control Board said today.

Stateline casinos, though, had the largest decline at 26.67 percent. North Las Vegas casinos posted the biggest increase at 20.72 percent.
