

# Private pilots need to plan ahead to fly to the Games



Flying your own plane to the Winter Games in February? It will take some planning.

Reno-Tahoe International Airport is one of three airports in the U.S. designated as an Olympic Portal airport for the 2010 Vancouver Winter Olympic Games.

Reno-Tahoe has three fixed based operators to assist pilots headed for the Games.

The reason for the portals is to have a handle on security, manage air space and parking.

Reservations must be made by private or corporate aircraft planning to fly into Vancouver for the Olympics. This can be done at [www.2010airportreservations.ca](http://www.2010airportreservations.ca).

Canadian officials predict nearly 500 aircraft will land in British Columbia each day during the two weeks of the Games.
