U.S. Postal Service puts its stamp on Olympics



The U.S. Postal Service is commemorating the Vancouver 2010 Olympic Winter Games with the issuance of a stamp featuring an illustration of a snowboarder.

The stamp went on sale this month.

Illustrator Steve McCracken captures the thrill of Olympic sports in his portrayal of an airborne snowboarder against the backdrop of a snow-capped mountain.

Stamps featuring Olympic themes have been popular since the first modern Olympiad in 1896, when Greece issued 12 Olympicthemed commemorative stamps. Beginning in 1932, when the Olympic Games were in Los Angeles, numerous U.S. stamps have honored the Games.
