El Dorado County youth dies on football field

An undiagnosed heart defect caused the death of an 11-year-old boy who collapsed during football practice, a pastor of the youngster's family said today.

The Rev. Chris Whited, youth pastor to the boy, said at a press conference that the family has been informed by the sheriff's department that the youngster died from the defect.
