Topics covered by the demonstration will include stencils, chine colle (collage using a press), and multiple drop printing. Monotype is a versatile printmaking medium that can accommodate a wide range of approaches.

She has participated in numerous shows regionally and nationally, most recently at Riverside Studio and Western Nevada Community College.
