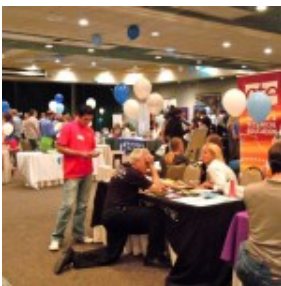


Tahoe business people mingle with potential customers
