

Fundraiser helps South Shore animals

The Animal Coalition of Tahoe has been working hard since the Mutt Strut in October – raising funds raffling several snowboards during the long winter, issuing more than 40 spay-neuter vouchers to bring the total in the past seven years to more than 1,500.
