

Robber strikes BofA in South Lake Tahoe

Moments after the Bank of America in South Lake Tahoe opened Monday morning it was robbed.



A suspect entered the branch at 3344 Lake Tahoe Blvd. just after 9am April 16 and demanded cash from a teller. No weapon was seen.

Officers are not releasing how much money the suspect got away with.

The suspect is described as a white male, about 5-foot-11, medium build, between 50- and 60-years-old, and clean shaven.
