

Nevada gaming win up, but not in Stateline

Stateline casinos did not pull their weight when it came to April gaming numbers.



Those five properties were down 4 percent, or almost \$14 million, compared to 2011. However, Nevada as a whole posted a 6.16 percent increase in year-over-year revenues with \$856 million brought in, the state Gaming Control Board said June 12.

Reno numbers were even worse than South Tahoe, with a decline of 19 percent or \$38 million.
