

South Tahoe neighborhood captains sought

If you live in the South Y Industrial, Bonanza, Barton, Winnemucca or Airport neighborhoods in South Lake Tahoe, there will be a meeting Sept. 5 at 6pm at Lake Tahoe Airport.

These meetings are informal.

Volunteer "captains" are being sought to be the main point of contact for their neighborhood area. A neighborhood "captain" would act as the liaison for their immediate neighbors.

Some examples of tasks that the neighborhood captain would perform include:

- Gather information for the neighborhood directory, current names, addresses, phone numbers, of those neighbors who want to be involved (this is voluntary).
- Make sure all neighbors receive the neighborhood newsletter or other informational flyers.
- Send any information you would like posted on your neighborhoods website page to your city contact for posting.
- Assist neighbors in identifying goals and activities within your neighborhood.
- Be the main contact person for you neighborhood group.
- Gather any concerns of potential code enforcement issues (on behalf of your neighbors), such as nuisances, garbage, and inform the code enforcement department.
