Spring Creek area pile burning to begin

U.S. Forest Service fuels management crews will conduct prescribed fire operations in the Spring Creek area near the south end of Lake Tahoe starting Nov. 1.

Crews anticipate burning 3 acres per day through the end of the week, conditions permitting.

Residents and visitors can expect to see smoke from this prescribed fire project area. The Forest Service strives to minimize the impacts of smoke on local communities. Smokesensitive residents should consider staying indoors and keeping doors, windows and outside vents closed.
