State transportation agency spending money near South Lake Tahoe

California Transportation Commission has allocated \$4.8 million to construct a water quality and collection and treatment facilities along Highway 50 west of South Lake Tahoe.

The CTC allocated \$236 million last week in new funding to 32 projects that will improve the state's transportation system and strengthen California's economy.

The allocations include \$81 million from Proposition 1B, a transportation bond approved by voters in 2006. In total, nearly \$14.5 billion in Proposition 1B funds have been distributed statewide.

The remaining \$155 million in allocations came from assorted transportation accounts funded by state and federal dollars.
