

8-acre controlled burn on N. Shore scheduled

North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District's fuels crew will continue the hazardous fuels reduction project in the Hunter Creek area on March 11, weather permitting.

This is projected to be a one-day event and crews will be monitoring and mopping up March 12.

This project is a cooperative effort between North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District, Reno Fire Department, Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and Washoe County Parks Department.

This 8-acre slash pile project was created as a result of a hazardous fuels reduction and defensible space project over the last year, to help minimize the risk of wildland fires in the area.
