

Tahoe poker players in top 10 at Harveys

Barry Kay of Incline Village placed second at a the World Series of Poker Circuit at Harveys in Stateline.

He won \$77,492.

There were 380 players competing for a prize pool of \$570,000.

Winning the four-day tournament was Jesse Wilke of Kenmore, Wash. He took home \$125,401, the gold championship ring, and will have a seat at the season-ending National Championship.

Robert Donahue of Zephyr Cove placed ninth, winning \$11,856.
