S. Lake Tahoe wants feedback on agenda items

South Lake Tahoe is launching eComment, a way to collect comments from citizens on agenda items.

It is designed to provide an easy way for people to give input and make participation in public meetings convenient. It is a web-based form that's tightly integrated with the city's published agenda. Residents can review agenda item details, indicate their position on an item and provide feedback.

All comments can be consolidated into a report and delivered to elected members prior to the meeting.

To utilize eComment, citizens must log onto the city's website prior to a meeting, and click on "Agendas and Minutes" on the homepage. To submit a comment, click the eComment link next to an upcoming meeting's agenda. The eComment feature is available for the June 2 City Council meeting.
