Boulder on Hwy. 50 to be removed Monday

Updated: Feb. 21, 5:50pm:

A boulder described as "far bigger than my SUV" by a passer-by is blocking one of the westbound lanes of Highway 50 near Logan Shoals.

The Nevada Highway Patrol told *Lake Tahoe News* the rock will not be able to be moved until at least Monday. It may take until Tuesday to clear it. It is 6-feet high and 9-feet wide.

It fell into the No. 2 lane about 6:20pm Feb. 20. That lane remains closed.

NHP said it caused a non-injury accident.
