

Children's book publishing and memoir classes in Meyers

Bona Fide Books & Letterpress in Meyers will offer two classes of interest to writers in May.

"So You Want to Write and/or Illustrate a Children's Book—Now What?" is the title of children's book author and illustrator Kristen Schwartz's class. It will be an intensive, personalized session aimed toward helping writers and illustrators of children's, middle grade and young adult books find their footing in the publishing industry.

The class is May 14 from 10am-2:30pm. Space is limited; the fee is \$75.
