

Gala benefits Tahoe summer music festival

Classical Tahoe, formerly Lake Tahoe SummerFest, is putting on a one-of-a-kind gala and fundraiser to kick off the summer festival.

White Nights, the third annual gala, will be July 10 at the lakefront estate of Kern Schumacher in Incline Village.

White Nights is a nod toward the popular international *diner en blanc* pop-up events that invite guests in major cities around the globe to don their finest white attire and descend on secret locations that are revealed at the last moment, with a gourmet picnics in tow.

Chef Mark Estee will be overseeing the food, while Chris Brubeck, son of legendary artist Dave Brubeck, and his ensemble Triple Play perform.
