Reliving Ali's fight at Stateline

Muhammad Ali fought professionally in Northern Nevada only once, on Nov. 21, 1972, at the Sahara-Tahoe Hotel (now Hard Rock) in Stateline. Ali died June 3 at the age of 74.
