

Report: Trump aides considered Sandoval for VP

Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump's top advisers wanted him to consider Nevada Gov. Brian Sandoval as a possible vice-presidential pick, according to an article in the *New York Times* magazine.

The article written by Robert Draper and published Wednesday details the selection process Trump undertook before finally deciding on Indiana Gov. Mike Pence. Trump's aides floated a few names, including Ohio Gov. John Kasich, Florida Sen. Marco Rubio and Sandoval, according to the article.

But there was one big hang-up that kept the idea from getting off the ground: Sandoval's support for Kasich late in the primary.
