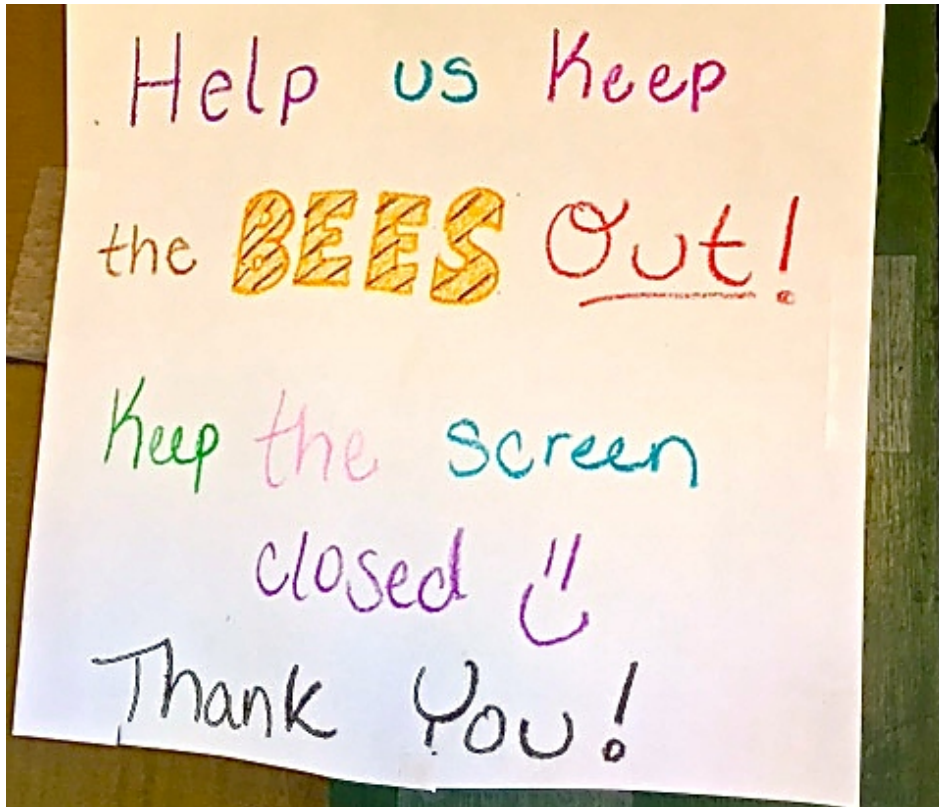


Aggressive yellow jackets a nuisance in Tahoe
