- South Lake Tahoe Fire Rescue's Brush 1 returned home Sept. 1 from the Chimney Fire in San Luis Obispo. SLTFR participates in the statewide mutual aid system. The city receives full reimbursement for its participation. The department calls back firefighters on their scheduled time off to provide normal coverage within the city.
- El Dorado County Superior Court is extending hours for Small Claims Night Court services. Night court in South Lake Tahoe will be the third Monday in November, March and July from 5:30-6:30pm.
- Douglas County Minden Library will be showing free movies geared toward adults and teens: Sept. 15 "Me Before You," Sept 29 "A Beautiful Mind," Oct. 13 "Rear Window," an Oct. 27 "Insidious." All shows begin at 2pm, with popcorn and beverages provided.
