

Letter: Fire a threat to Martis Valley project

Dear Board of Supervisors,

I am submitting **this article** for the record for the Martis Valley West Parcel Specific Plan as further evidence that the MVWPSP FEIR did not take into consideration the threat of wildland urban interface. A CalFire representative was consulted by Planning Commissioner [Wayne] Nader who had extensive conversations about the location and the problematic terrain and ability to adequately protect and evacuate the public among other issues when a fire erupts.

Note the attached article brings forth the 10 most expensive fires in the West's history. Six of the 10 fires are in California in locations that are similar forested areas much like the proposed MVWPSP.
