Multiple windows in multiple classrooms were broken at Douglas High School.

"The means to how the windows were broken are being withheld at this time for investigation purposes. The classrooms are still useable," Douglas County sheriff's Investigator Jon Storke told Lake Tahoe News.

A dollar value for the damage has not been given.

The incident occurred in the early morning hours of Dec. 21.
