Bodie becomes temporary terrain park

Freestyle skier Cody LaPlante rattled the ghosts of Bodie has he turned the ghost town into a terrain park.

Assisted by a safety and State Parks team, LaPlante and the crew built a dream ski park within the eerie buildings this month. They traveled 13 miles via snowmobile.

Dating back to around 1859, Bodie is frozen in a state of "arrested decay."

"Doing interesting and urban skiing projects like this really helps progress the sport and I want to be a part of that," LaPlante said in a statement.
