Tragedy was averted Friday with the help of North Tahoe firefighters.

A man needed rescuing from the Truckee River near River Ranch on June 30 at about 2:20pm.

"Apparently he was tubing down the Truckee River when he got stuck on one of the pilings of a bridge due to a complication of a rope he had attached to two inner tubes," Beth Kenna, spokeswoman for the fire department, told *Lake Tahoe News*.

Assisting North Tahoe Fire were CHP and Squaw Valley Fire personnel.

"The water is swift and what you think is a safe situation can turn dangerous in seconds," Kenna said.
