## SNC reducing staff to manage its budget

Sierra Nevada College is cutting positions in order to be fiscally solvent.

The 2017-18 budget includes the elimination of 4.75 full time equivalent positions (this affects six people); reduction in hours equivalent to affect the equivalent of 1.5 FTE positions (six individuals) being reduced from full to three-quarter time (still benefit eligible), and 4.5 FTE positions (seven individuals) currently vacant that will remain unfilled.

According to a press release, "The goal is to build the longterm sustainability of the college by optimizing enrollment at the main campus in Incline Village and through growth strategies that include adding new partnerships, focusing on high-demand fields of study, and expanding online programs. The college's highest priority is always to preserve the student-centered, high-value, unique educational experience for which SNC Tahoe has become well-known."

The satellite campus at Lake Tahoe Community College will not be adversely impacted.
