An Olympian's guide to Truckee's hot spots

Now Davis' eyes are set on the 2018 Winter Olympics in Pyeongchang, South Korea, where he hopes to parlay his X Games success into victory on the global stage. He'll represent the United States in the snowboarding halfpipe event.
