

Nev. looks to learn from past mistakes in health platform switch

CARSON CITY – The state's health exchange under the Affordable Care Act is moving off the federal platform for signing up for insurance, relying on lessons learned in the past and in other states.

Vendors have until 2pm April 13 to file proposals with the Silver State Health Exchange and must adhere to strict requirements. The goal is to avoid mistakes made the first time around, said Heather Korbolic, the exchange's executive director.

Korbolic said only about a handful of companies have built successful platforms under the Affordable Care Act.

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
