- El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has a special meeting scheduled for April 20 at 9am in Placerville. The lone item: "Chief Administrative Office recommending the board receive information and provide direction regarding priorities for the fiscal year 2018-19 budget."
- With this week's storm, Squaw Valley officially hit the 400-inch mark of cumulative snowfall during the 2017-18 winter season.
