Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Morning Mountain Resort Report for your Saturday January 23rd. Should be a great day to enjoy the slopes. Plenty of Fresh Snow and Mostly Cloudy Skies with continued Scattered Snow Showers expected today. Temps into the Low 20's on the Slopes. Some Light to Moderate winds reported. Dress warm, layer up today and wear your Windproof - Waterproof Jacket. Take along a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety. Wear Good Goggles & Warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier-Rider Packed Powder. National Safety Awareness Week on the Slopes – Please review the Skier & Rider Responsibility Codes. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a Buddy if you go Off Piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only".

South Lake Tahoe & Surrounding Area Resorts

Heavenly Mountain Resort - South Lake Tahoe – Reports 2-3" of new on a base of 39-58". 28 Lifts are scheduled to operate (8:30-4)-WWP. Access to the mountain will be from The Gondola, CA Base Lodge, Stagecoach Lodge and Boulder Lodge on the NV side. 14 Lifts on the CA Side & 14 Lifts on the Nevada Side including Mott Canyon. 85 trails are accessible + Powder Bowl T-Park.
