Good Morning Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Tuesday, March 16th. Shaping up to be another Great Day to make turns... Expect Mostly Clear to Partly Cloudy Skies with Temps warming into the 50's on the Slopes and Light to Moderate Winds with possible Stronger Gusts. Dress in light layers with your Jacket or Shell. Take a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety. Also, wear good Sunglasses or Goggles. Don't forget to use the sunscreen and stay well hydrated. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed and Skier / Rider Packed Powder. Some Softening and turning to Spring Snow on Southern exposures. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a buddy if go off-piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only".

South Lake Tahoe & Surrounding Area Resorts

***Heavenly Mountain Resort** - South Lake Tahoe – Reports a base of 69-101". 28 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4) Access to the mountain will be from The Gondola, The CA Base Lodge and both Stagecoach and Boulder Lodges on the NV side. 14 Lifts are scheduled on the CA Side & 14 Lifts on the Nevada Side. 94 trails are open (70+MG), Plus 3 Terrain Parks on the CA side. Adventure Peak activities at the top of the Gondola are scheduled to open (11-4:30) with the Snow Tubing, Sledding, Snowshoeing & Snow Bikes for Rent. (MG & SKRPP / 36F / Clear / Lt-Mod Winds). ***Sierra-At-Tahoe** - on U.S. Hwy 50 – Reports a base of 59-128". 8 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4) including Grandview Express to the top, West Bowl & Short Stuff on the backside open. 48 Trails are open (36MG) + Jacks Bowl and Avalanche Bowl Open. Gate 1 accessing Huckleberry Canyon Open – Check with Patrol at the top. 4 T-Parks, Boarder X & Super Pipe are open. (MG & SKRPP / 35F / Clear & Lt Winds). ***Hope Valley XC Outdoor Center** - 14655 Hwy 89/88 – at Pickett's Junction is open (10-5) They have a base of 30-68". They and have 60 miles of Marked and Skier Packed Trails and 25 miles of groomed trails open. No Fees to XC or Snowshoe up in Hope Valley and No Snow Park fees. ***Kirkwood Mountain Resort** - On Hwy 88 – Reports a base from 130-190".
