Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Thursday, March 25th. Some Fresh Snow... The forecast is calling Mostly Cloudy Skies with Isolated Snow Showers with Temps into the mid high 30's to low 40's on the Slopes and Light to Moderate Winds with Stronger Gusts that could affect the operation of upper mountain lifts. Dress warm in layers with your Windproof – Waterproof Jacket. Take a hat, Beanie or wear a helmet for safety. Also, wear good Goggles. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed and Skier / Rider Packed Spring Snow... Firm Pack in the morning then Softening with rising day-time temperatures. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a buddy if go off-piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only".

South Lake Tahoe & Surrounding Area Resorts

Heavenly Mountain Resort - South Lake Tahoe – Reports 1-3" of new on a base of 69-101". 27 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4)-WWP. Access to the mountain will be from The Gondola on HOLD, The CA Base Lodge and both Stagecoach and Boulder Lodges on the NV side. 13 Lifts are scheduled on the CA Side & 14 Lifts on the Nevada Side. (Sky-Tamarack-Dipper – North Bowl on HOLD) 94 trails are open (70+MG), Plus 3 Terrain Parks on the CA side. Adventure Peak activities at the top of the Gondola are scheduled to open (11-4:30) with the Snow Tubing, Sledding, Snowshoeing & Snow Bikes for Rent. (Pwdr, MG & SKRPkd / Spring / 25F / MCldy / Mod-Strong Winds). Spring Loaded kicks off this weekend with Pond Skimming both Saturday and Sunday and the Snowed Inn Rail Jam & Concert at Mont Bleu on Saturday. Sierra-At-Tahoe - on U.S. Hwy 50 – Reports 2" of new on a base of 46-108". 9 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4) including Grandview Express to the top, West Bowl & the backside open. 48 Trails are open (39MG) + Jacks Bowl and Avalanche Bowl Open. Gate 1 accessing Huckleberry Canyon Open – Check with Patrol at the top. 4 T-Parks, Boarder X & Super Pipe are open. (MG & SKRPkd / Spring / 30F / Cldy & Lt-Mod Winds). They also have Snow Shoe Trails & The Tubing Hill open. Hosting the VZ Highlander 2 – The Jibbing Event on Saturday. Hope Valley XC Outdoor Center - 14655 Hwy 89/88 (R1) – at Pickett's Junction is open (10-5) They have a base of 30-56". They and have 60 miles of Marked and Skier Packed Trails and 25 miles of groomed trails open. No Fees to XC or Snowshoe up in Hope Valley and No Snow Park fees. Kirkwood Mountain Resort - On Hwy 88 – Reports 1" of new on a base from 130-190". All 12 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4)-WWP with Chairs #6 & #10 to the top of the Front Side + 5 Lifts to the Back Side including the Vista & Covered Wagon tows; and all Timber Creek Lifts to turn. 72 Trails are accessible (46MG) + 7 Bowls, 3 T-Parks, Skier/Boarder X and the Half Pipe open. Northstar-at-Tahoe - On Hwy 267 (R1) – Reports 3-4" of new on a base of 28-94". 15 Lifts are scheduled to operate (8:30-4)-WWP. They are open top to bottom - Front to Back including Lookout Mountain. 91 trails are open (62 MG) + 7 T-Parks open & Super Pipe Open. (Pwdr, MG & SKRPkd / Spring / 32F / Lt Snow / Lt-Mod Winds). **Northstar**
