Good Morning Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Saturday, March 6th. Expect Mostly Cldy Skies with Isolated and Scattered Snow Showers thru out the day. Temps into the low to mid 30's on the Slopes and Light Winds. Dress warm, in layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Take a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety. Wear good Goggles. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed and Skier / Rider Packed Powder. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a buddy if go off-piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only". Also Hwy 28 thru Tahoe City will be closed from 11:30 till 12:30 for Annual Snowfest Parade.
