




Lead Safe Worker Training

TRAINING AT LAKE TAHOE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SET TO BEGIN APRIL 23, 2010

The City has partnered with Lake Tahoe Community College Foundation to provide two types of training for local contractors: (1) Lead Safe Worker 8-hour training for Renovators, Repair and Painters and (2) Supervisor training for up to Ten General Contractors.

LEAD SAFE WORKER TRAINING

Who: Construction workers

When: Friday, April 23rd or Saturday, May 1st

Where: Offered at LTCC, Room A208 (upstairs)

Cost: City/LTCC Foundation will cover all but \$50 of training. Bring Your Own Lunch

Registration is First-come, First-served. Up to two workers from each local firm, until registration is full. Registration open to additional employees space permitting. Register at LTCC, Physical Education Building 11:00 am to 1:00 p.m. April 19 and 20.

LEAD SAFE SUPERVISOR TRAINING

Ten local General Contractors are being offered the opportunity to attend a five-day course to become certified Lead Safe Worker Supervisors. Registration is limited to one supervisor from each local firm. This five-day course is offered in Richmond, CA. Registration (\$850) will be covered by City/LTCC Foundation partnership. Hotels/and other travel expenses covered by participant.



All Participants MUST agree to submit bids for the City's Lead Hazard Control Construction project over the next two years, depending on their availability.
