Many Resorts turned off their lifts after yesterday and yesterday turned out to be a glorious day on the slopes. For today, Expect Partly Cloudy Skies in the morning then Mostly Cloudy later in the day. temps warming up into the upper 50's on the Slopes with Light to Mod Winds increasing to 40mph in the after with possible ridge gusts up to 60mph. Dress in light layers with your Jacket or Shell. Take a Hat with a brim or Visor or wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles and don't forget the Sunscreen and Re-apply it thru-out the day. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed & Skier-Rider Packed Spring Snow – Firm Packed softening with rising day-time temperatures. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a Buddy if go off-piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only". A late season Weather System will move thru starting tonight bringing snow to our region thru tomorrow.
