Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Thursday, April 22nd. Just a few Resorts remaining open thru this weekend. More Powder and a Winter that just doesn't want to quit! Expect Winter Conditions with Scattered Snow Showers and temps only in low 30's on the Slopes. Also Light to Mod Winds. All Lift Operations will be Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress warm in layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Take a Hat, Beanie or wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles and warm gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier-Rider Packed Snow. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a Buddy if go off-piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only".
