Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Saturday, April 10th. Expect Mostly Cloudy Skies and Increasing Light to Moderate Winds with Isolated Snow Showers in the afternoon. Temps will be warming into the low 40's on the slopes. Winds will increase between 50-65 mph over the Ridge tops by afternoon and could affect the operation of upper mountain lifts. Be aware of possible Lift Status changes or Call Ahead. Dress in layers with your Windproof Waterproof Jacket. Take a Hat, Beanie or wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles. Don't forget the Sunscreen when the Sun is out. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed & Skier-Rider Packed Spring Snow – Firm in the morning and softening with rising day-time temperatures. Ski and Ride with Care and always with a Buddy if go off-piste. Keep an eye out for marked and unmarked obstacles and "Stay In Bounds and on opened runs only".


