Sierra Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday June 13 - 19, 2010

SPECIAL EVENTS

On **State Route 28** at the Sierra Boat Company, 5146 State Route 28, Carnelian Bay: Motorists can expect intermittent one-traffic controls **June 15 through June 20**. The controls are for the annual Lake Tahoe Concours d'Elegance Wooden Boat Show.

LONG-TERM CLOSURE

On Interstate 80, the east and westbound Donner Rest Areas will be closed from **May 3, 2010 to May 1, 2011**. A contractor is schedule to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

On Interstate 80, the westbound connector to the CHP Truck Inspection Facility will be closed from **May 10 to July 14**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 28 (Placer County) in Kings Beach: Work has resumed on a \$46 million environmental improvement project to reconstruct drainage facilities and improve the road surface. Completion is expected in the fall of 2011.

June 14 - June 18

On State Route 28 from Lardin Way to Estates Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 p.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work has begun on a \$31 million project to add bus/carpool lanes to U.S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County. Completion is expected in the fall of 2011. No traffic interfering work is scheduled.

<u>June 13 - June 19</u>

On U.S. Highway 50 between the El Dorado/Sacramento County line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. (8 a.m. Saturday) Sunday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work has begun on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portand Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems.

June 13 - June 18

On Intestate 80 from Rainbow to Cisco Grove: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **9 p.m. Sunday through 9 a.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do slap repair work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaying the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2011. <u>Project is on</u> <u>suspension.</u>

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Lake to Donner Pass Road in Truckee: Work continues on the \$70 million Donner I construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems, construction of a westbound truck-climbing lane from Donner Pass Road to the Donner Lake

Interchange and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2010.

June 14 - June 18

On Interstate 80 between Trout Creek and Donner Lake: Motorists can expect the westbound #1 lane closed from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. (10 a.m. Friday) Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do barrier work.

<u>June 13 - June 18</u>

On Interstate 80 from Donner Lake to Donner Pass Road: Motorists can expect the eastbound #2 lane closure from **10 p.m. Sunday through 9 a.m. Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Boca to the Nevada State line: Work continues on the \$73 million Truckee River Canyon construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaying the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems, construction of a westbound truck-climbing lane from Donner Pass Road to the Donner Lake Interchange and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2010.

June 14 - June 28

On Interstate 80 at Farad: Motorists can expect the westbound on and off-ramps closed from **June 14 through June 28.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.
