This is to notify you that the project described below has been scheduled for the above-noticed public hearing:

Project Description: The State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing to replace deteriorating rock parapet walls at seven locations on US Highway 50 in El Dorado County on Echo Summit. The barrier wall is deteriorated in several places. The new barrier will retain the visual qualities of the historic barrier. Caltrans is also replacing all existing steel guardrails and installing water quality improvements within the project area. The area approximately includes US Highway 50 from Echo Summit eastbound to Johnson Pass Road and will include a temporary road closure during construction.
