Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your First Mountain Resort Report as of Friday, November 19th. It's the Kick Off Weekend for many Resorts and with that, of course the First significant Series of Winter Storm of the season is expected to affect the region this weekend. A Winter Storm Warning is now posted in effect from 4pm this afternoon thru 4pm, Sunday afternoon. 3 to 5 Feet of snow is expected above 7000 ft. and 1 to 2 feet below. Expect Cold Temperatures in to the Mid 20's on the slopes, increasing clouds and snow in the afternoon and increasing moderate to strong gusty winds that may affect the operation of upper mountain lifts... So, all lift operations will be Wind and Weather permitting. Dress for Winter conditions in your Windproof – Waterproof Jacket, take alone a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety; also wear good goggles and warm gloves. Surface conditions today are mainly MG machine made snow. Ski and Ride with care, as early season conditions exist so keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles and stay on opened runs only.
