Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for Tuesday, November 30th. Forecast Calling for Mostly Cloudy Skies in with Temps warming into the mid 30's to low 40's the Slopes and Light Winds. Dress warm, wear your Jacket, take along a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety; Also, wear Good Goggles. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed and Skier-Rider Packed Powder & Machine Made Snow. Ski and Ride with care. Early season conditions exist so keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles and stay on opened runs only.
