Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for Monday, November 22nd. It's going to be another Pre-Thanksgiving Powder Day! More Snow is coming thru for the next couple of days as well as those strong gusty winds. Temperatures in to the mid 20's on the slopes with Moderate to Strong Winds that may affect the operation of upper mountain lifts... So, all lift operations will be Wind and Weather Permitting – Call Ahead. Dress for Winter conditions in your Windproof – Waterproof Jacket, take along a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety; Also, wear good goggles and warm gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, MG Powder & MM Snow. Ski and Ride with care. Early season conditions exist so keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles and stay on opened runs only.

Heavenly Mountain Resort - South Lake Tahoe – Reports 12" of new and a base of 41-49". 3 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4)-WWP with access to the mountain from the Gondola, Tamarack Express and adding Dipper Express today on the upper mountain – WWP.
