Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for Sunday, November 28th. Winter Weather is moving out today. Expect Mostly Cloudy Skies in the Morning with isolated Snow Showers, turning to Partly Cloudy in the afternoon. Temps only into the mid 20's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds. Dress warm in your Windproof – Waterproof Jacket, take along a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety; Also, wear Good Goggles and warm gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed and Skier / Rider Packed Powder & MM Snow. Ski and Ride with care. Early season conditions exist so keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles and stay on opened runs only.
