Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for Sunday, December 12th. Shaping up to be a Beautiful Day for Skiing & Riding or doing anything outdoors. Sunny - Clear Skies with Temps warming up into the low 50's on the Slopes and Light Winds. Take along your Jacket or a Shell, wear a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety; Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles and don't forget to apply Sunscreen when the sun is out. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed and Skier-Rider Packed Snow softening with day time temperatures. Ski and Ride with care. Early season conditions exist, so keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles and stay on opened runs only.

South Lake Tahoe & Surrounding Area Resorts

*Heavenly Mountain Resort - South Lake Tahoe – Reports a base of 45-54". 22 Lifts are scheduled to operate (8:30-4). 12 Lifts scheduled in California and 10 Lifts on the Nevada Side.
