Happy Holidays, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Thursday, December 30th. Going to be a Great Day to Enjoy Powder Skiing & Riding. The Storm has moved thru and today you'll find Mostly Cloudy Skies with Isolated Snow Showers. Temps will be much colder on the mountain only getting in the low 20's. Light to Moderate Winds with possible Ridge Gusts up to 60 mph could affect the operation of upper mountain lifts so lift operations will be Wind & Weather Permitting... Call Ahead. Dress for Winter Conditions, Bundle up in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket, wear a hat, beanie or wear a helmet for safety – take a scarf or face gaiter; Also, wear Good Goggles & Warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed Powder & Wind Packed Snow. Ski and Ride with care. Keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles – Always Ski with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and stay on opened runs only.
