Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for Monday, December 6th. There's Fresh Powder and that Winter Weather Advisory expires at 7am this morning. Expect Mostly Cloudy Skies and Scattered Showers in the Morning then Partly Cloudy in the Afternoon. Temperatures will be into the upper 30's on the Slopes with Moderate to Strong Winds that may hamper the operation of upper mountain Lifts this morning and subsiding thru out the day. So, Upper Mtn Lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress for Winter Weather with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket, wear a hat, beanie or a helmet for safety; Also, wear Good Goggles and warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed and Skier-Rider Packed Powder. Ski and Ride with care. Early season conditions exist so keep an eye for marked and unmarked obstacles and stay on opened runs only.
