Expect Partly Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy Skies by afternoon and Temps in the Low 40's on the Slopes and Light Winds. Dress in Layers with your Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles. And, Don't forget to use sunscreen when the sun is out! Surface conditions are Machine Groomed & Skier/ Rider Packed Powder. Ski and Ride with care.
