Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Tuesday, February 1st. Expect Mostly Clear Sunny Skies with Temps into the low-20's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds. Stronger Gusts up to 70 mph over the Ridge Tops may hamper the operation of upper mountain lifts in the afternoon, so be aware. Dress in Layers with your Windproof Jacket or Shell. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles. Don't forget to use Sunscreen when the sun is out. Surface conditions are Variable with and Machine Groomed &NSkier Rider Packed Powder and some area of Firm Packed Snow. Ski and Ride with Care. Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles – Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
